

Aftercare for Monofibre Hair Extensions

Whether you have decided to add length, volume, texture or colour to your hair, you have chosen the worlds most successful hair extension and enhancer system – Monofibre which is preferred by top hairdressers everywhere.

We want you to be totally satisfied with your new style and we see it as part of our responsibility to help you care for it in between visits to the salon.

Follow a few simple maintenance tips and your extensions or enhancers will be trouble free and continue to look and feel as great as they are today.

Shampoo and Conditioning

Allow 3-4 days before your first shampoo unless your natural hair is very prone to oiliness. Use a good quality frequent wash shampoo; cleanse your hair in warm water massaging the scalp lightly. After every shampoo you must apply a conditioner to the mid lengths and ends avoiding the root area. Using your fingers or a wide toothed comb, gently separate the Monofibre and comb the conditioner through to the ends. Take care to rinse thoroughly with warm water.

Brushing

Monofibre should be brushed at least once a day, but only ever with a soft bristle brush. We will show you the special technique on how to hold each section of hair. Before brushing, always spray the hair with a light mist of CARE daily Care Mist to promote shine and eliminate static. CARE daily care mist does not build up on the hair and MUST be used prior to any heat styling.

Drying and Styling

For the best results, leave to dry naturally and gently lift the hair away from the head to create more volume. If wearing a wave style, dry using heat from a warm hair dryer with a diffuser attachment. Finish with the dryer on cold to set the movement. You can use any hairstyling products e.g. mousse, gel or hairspray on your Monofibre by applying to almost dry hair.

Removal

During the life of the extension hairstyle, a couple of extensions may come out. This is quite normal and in no way affects the finished look. Within the two or three months you are wearing the extensions, you may wish to have them tidied up. As all hairstyles created with Monofibre are individually designed for you, your stylist will advise of any other aftercare procedures required to keep your hairstyle looking good. It is not necessary to cut your natural hair to remove extensions or enhancers. Removal can be done during a salon visit or by yourself simply by twisting the hard attachment to break it down before unraveling the braided area until the Monofibre can be separated from your normal hair. After you have removed all of your extension you should apply an intense conditioning treatment to the dry hair and gently comb through to remove tangles, you can then shampoo as normal.
