

Monofibre Extensions – Frequently Asked Questions

How long does it take to have a total change of look? We can transform you completely in about 3 hours, however depending on your requirements it may sometimes take less or sometimes more.

Are your extensions made of real human hair?

No. We do not use real human hair and there is a reason for it. Would you really feel comfortable wearing second-hand human hair? We prefer (just as many celebrities do) to use monofibre. It is a special material that looks and feels like natural hair, but is totally hygienic and does not cause any allergies.

Isn't human hair the best for extensions?

If all you want is a totally natural look, natural hair is paradoxically not the best option. If you want beautiful, silky smooth hair, with a colour that matches your own, there is nothing quite like the monofibre. It also has the added benefit of being more affordable and hygienic.

How are Monofibre hair extensions attached?

We use very gentle heat to attach our monofibre hair extensions. No chemicals are used during the process so it is totally hair-friendly and allergy free. The attachment is so subtle that no one will tell the difference!

Can hair extensions damage my own hair?

The process we use is totally hair-friendly. We know how important your hair is to you so we don't use any glues or chemicals during the application or removal. We only use gentle heat to attach the extensions, so you never get any rashes, allergies or damaged hair.

Can I straighten the extensions?

There will be no need. Monofibre extensions can be straightened at the time of the application, so in case you want to go for the straight hair look, you will just have to iron your own hair.

Will they get ugly with time?

Not if you follow the basic, really simple aftercare guidelines we will provide you with. If you stick to a few rules then your look will be preserved for much longer time.

How long will they last?

Monofibre hair extensions can last up to three months, provided that you read and comply with our aftercare guidelines.
